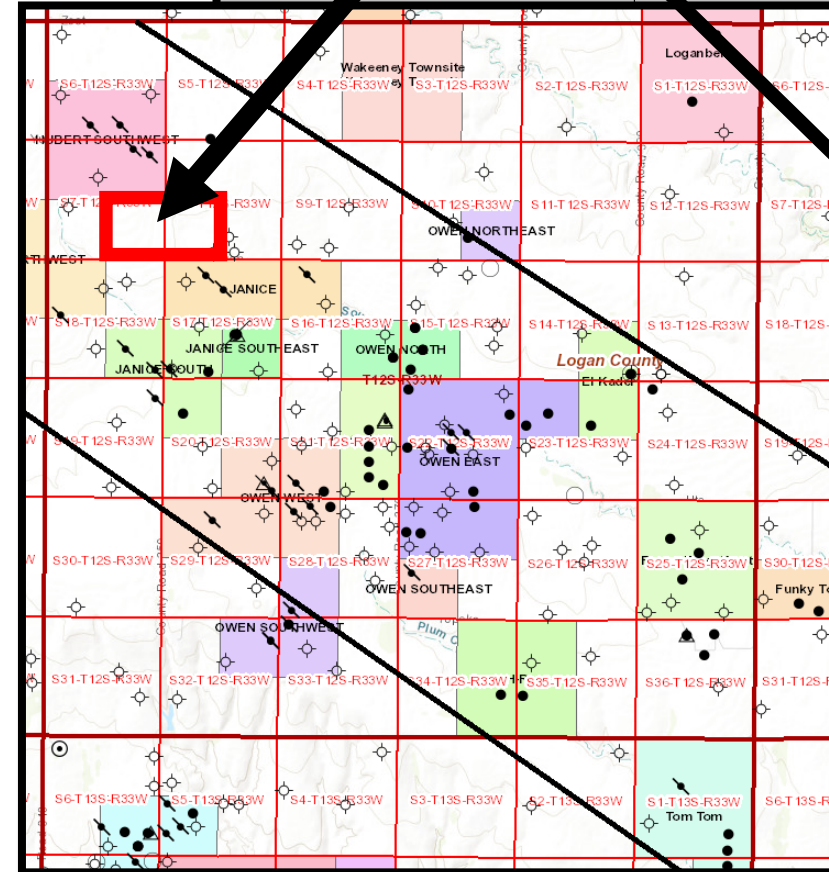
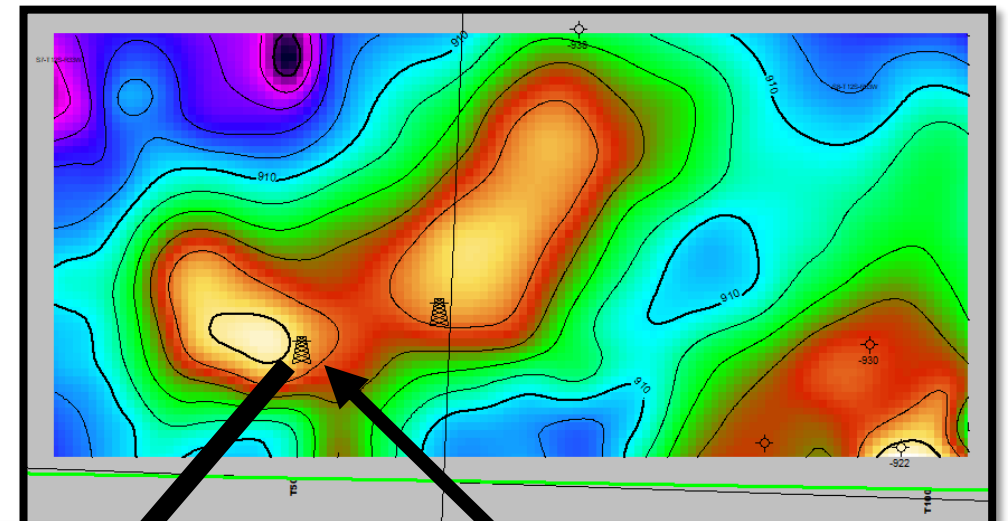


# Monument Drilling Project

Geographic Setting: 6 miles south of Monument, Kansas located within Logan County.

- Logan County Cumulative Oil Production: 20,480,428 bbls
- Logan County Oil Production 2018: 791,432 bbls
- Monument Prospect (320 acres) located within large NW-SE trend
- Prospect defined by: 3-D Seismic, Sub-Sea mapping from well control, production research, log Interpretation, and stratigraphic research.
- Primary targets include, Lansing/Kansas City “E” Zone, Lansing/Kansas City “J” Zone, and Johnson Zone (lower Cherokee)
- Secondary targets include: Toronto Limestone, Lansing/KC A,H,I,K zones, Lenapah Lime, Altamont, Myrick Station, Fort Scott (Oswego), Cherokee Limestone, Morrow Sandstone, Mississippian
- Primary Recovery of 148,000 bbls possible from 3 primary target formations (see additional slides with volumetric parameters)
- 2 Primary locations identified by 3-D Seismic
- Janice Unit (1/2 mile SE, similar feature, 2 wells) estimated **total cashflow exceeded \$5,300,000.00.**
